Reminder GCSE Entries for June 2014



Students entering for the first time

All required unit codes and respective cash-in code need to be entered, in order to receive a final overall grade.

Students resitting a GCSE

Only controlled assessment unit(s) which have been certificated can be carried forward from previous exams series. All externally assessed units must be entered alongside the respective cash-in code.

Change to Amendment Fees

In response to your feedback, we have changed the way in which we charge for tier amendments of GCSE units in the June 2014 examination session.



All tier changes will now be charged as amendment fees regardless of whether or not the F or H option is part of the unit code or an option code.

This means that any amendments to tiers or option codes will be free of charge until the amendment fee deadline which is 4 April 2014.



March 2014 results for next generation NQF BTEC in Applied Science

On receipt of your results for the March 2014 assessment opportunity for next generation NQF BTECs, learners may decide that they would like to re-sit units in the June 2014 assessment window.

If so you may enter the students for re-sits of units that they sat in March 2014, providing that re-sit entries are made by 30 April.

We will not charge you late fees for these test bookings.
