GCSE reform

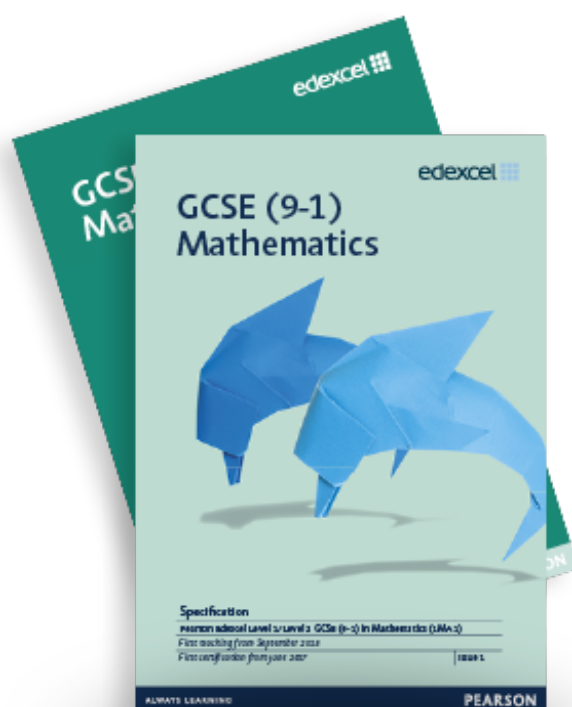
