ResultsPlus Direct – a tool for students

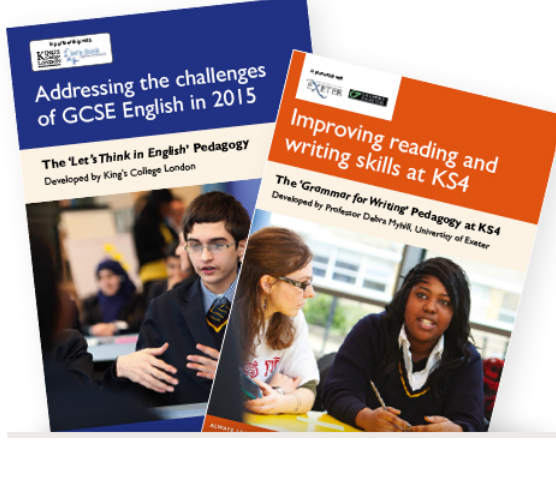

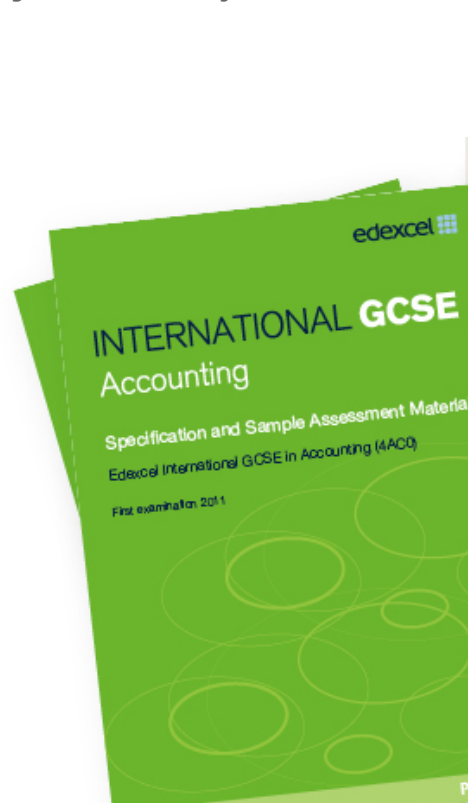
International GCSE
