### ResultsPlus and ResultPlus Direct

ResultsPlus was launched in 2007 and is used by over 35,000 teachers and 5,000 centres annually.

ResultsPlus is a free online service that provides detailed analysis of a students' exam result, this analysis is linked to performance and helps to identify topics and skills where students could benefit from further learning.

[ResultsPlus Direct](#) is the student version of ResultsPlus, with around 65,000 users from 1,000 centres since launch in 2013. Both services are used our UK and International customers with a focus on GCSE's and A level, including IAL analysis.


Post-Results Services will be available for International GCSE and IAL from Thursday 5th March 2015.

## Reminder: Entry deadline for summer 2015 examinations

You may have received subject specific newsletters stating that the entry deadline date is the 21st February 2015. This deadline applies to centres based in the UK only.

Please note that deadline date for IAL, International GCSE, GCSE, GCE, PLSC and DiDA entries for international centres will remain to be on the **21st March 2015** as with previous years. Any entries received after the entry deadline may incur a late fee. Please see below for the other associated dates:

**Entry deadline:** 21st March 2015

**Amendment deadline:** 21st April 2015

**Final date by which withdrawn entries will be refunded:** 21st April 2015

**Higher late fees may apply from this date:** 22nd April 2015




## Online Exams Officer Training 2015
