## Becoming an approved centre

To be able to deliver our qualifications you will need to become an approved centre. Your dedicated Pearson representative will be your main point of contact to support your application.

Your Pearson representative will visit to inspect your premises, to check that your organisation meets security and administration requirements and procedures for the conduct of examinations/tests.

Once your inspection visit has taken place your Pearson representative will submit your completed application for processing, which will be reviewed by a member of the International Approvals team.

# What makes approval important?

To maintain the reliability and credibility of Pearson's exams, we must be confident that all schools offering our qualifications will keep our exam materials secure. Inspection visits and approvals mean that we know every school working with us meets our security standards, and will run exams in a consistent way, wherever they are in the world.

Our inspection visits are guided by JCQ General Regulations and <u>Instructions for delivering exams</u> which are updated annually to support schools in delivering best practice.

JCQ's 'Are You Ready' checklist will help you prepare for the inspection visit. The visit will give particular attention to your secure storage facilities, so please check these requirements before we visit you.

You will receive an approval certificate, direct from our approvals team, to certify that you are an approved centre.



# Finance and iPay Overview

## Your self-service portal – iPay

In addition to receiving invoices electronically or by post, you can view, print, and download invoices and statements using iPay (iReceivables).

Your self service finance portal iPay allows you to:

- make secure payments by card online
- · download copies of invoices and credit notes
- view or download your current statement of account.

This service is available twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, all year round.

**Please note:** your finance account is not the same as your Centre number (NCN) which is given to you when you are approved as a Pearson qualification customer.

### **Account and Billing information**

Invoices are generated weekly, and statements on the first Tuesday of the month and both are sent to your billing address as held in our records.

### **Your Billing Address**

Your first invoice and statement will be sent to the postal address you provided at the centre approval stage. However, you will receive them more quickly, and to the right person if we can send them electronically. Your electronic billing address should be a company finance email address, i.e. <a href="mailto:finance@testcentre.org">finance@testcentre.org</a>. If you believe we have an incorrect billing address, or you wish to update your records, please complete our 'Updating Our Records' form, allowing up to 10 days for changes to take effect. You must also update your finance contact and billing records in Edexcel Online on a regular basis.

## Finance and iPay Overview (continued)

If you have any queries about the charges on an invoice, or wish to dispute an invoice please create a case record by **contacting us** (select Invoicing, Statements & Payments in the Issue Type and Invoice Dispute in the Category Type).

Payment cannot be withheld unless you dispute the amount of the charges within 21 days of receipt of an invoice, as detailed in section 10 of the <u>Terms and conditions</u>. You will need to give full details of the amounts disputed and the reason for your dispute.

### **Understanding your Statements and Invoices**

Our statements provide a monthly summary of all open transactions on your account. If an invoice is partially paid, it will be shown on your statement as 'Original Amount' and 'Outstanding Amount'; the statement of account only shows outstanding receivables. This will include open transactions such as invoices, credits, and debits.

Historical invoices or those that are fully paid will no longer be part of the current Statement of Account (SOA).

## **Making Payments**

Payment for all fees is due **30 days** from the date of the invoice. You can find more information on the different methods of payment below.

#### **Remittance Advice**

Each time you make a payment, unless doing so with credit card via iPay, you will need to send a remittance advice to <a href="mailto:cashrec@pearson.com">cashrec@pearson.com</a>. This will ensure your payments are allocated correctly to your account. You will need to advise us of how to apply any credit notes in the same way.
