Task One (14 marks - 2 for each correct answer)

computer marked

Example: b

1. c

Task Two (16 marks - 2 for each correct answer)

clerically marked

Example: Carlin

1. 45 km(s)/kilometres/kilometers/ forty-five km etc (as words)
2. 12/twelve years ago (must include 'ago' or 'before')
3. (It was) quiet/(because it was) quiet/the quiet
4. Tregas [must be spelt correctly]
5. Tuesday/Tues
6. 6.00 / six (pounds) (per / an hour)
7. 8 / eight (pm) [am is wrong]/o' clock/20.00
8. (With) (his /the) (next door) neighbour / Mike

Task Three (15 marks - max 3 for each answer depending on degree of accuracy - to be discussed at standardisation)

expert marked

Example: When did you move into your house, Mike?

1. Do you prefer living in the country or the city? Which is best, living in the country or the city? Is it better to live in the country or / than the city? What do you think about living in the country?/Why did you move here/to the country? Why do you live in the country/here?
2. What's the best thing (for you) about living here? What do you like most about living here?
3. How often do you (usually) go fishing (every / in a week)?
4. Are you going (to go) fishing this weekend/on Saturday?
5. Can you teach me to fish (please, Mike)?

Task Four (10 marks - 2 for each correct answer)

clerically marked

Example: Come in! It's lovely and warm.

1. Put these on when you get in the boat.
2. Where did you catch them?
3. Careful! Don't fall in.
4. Look at it jumping everywhere!
5. Come on. I'll help you.

(Distracters: No, thank you. I don't want it. I am fishing with my friends.)

Task Five (15 marks - 1.5 for each)

expert marked
