
- 1- **Download and save a PDF copy to your PC/Laptop.**
- 2- **Open Test Paper PDF in Adobe Acrobat Reader.**
It is important you are editing the actual pdf which has been previously saved in your laptop/PC rather than opening it on a browser to ensure you have access to all edit options.
- 3- In **Adobe Acrobat Reader**, **turn on Commenting**. This will allow lines or arrows to be drawn on the Test Paper on the relevant questions.

Look at the pictures of the Brown family and Rachel at the museum. Draw a line from the pictures to the correct sentences. The first one is an example.


