












Remote Invigilation Assessments

Provider Assessment Conditions Checklist

**Are your learners ready to take their assessment at home?
Take a few minutes and go through the checklist to make sure.**

	Review all information about Remote Invigilation on our dedicated web page	
	If you are new to the service complete the Intention to Offer form	
	Receive confirmation that onboarding is completed.	
	Speak to learners to ensure that Remote Invigilation is suitable for them and share learner guidance with them	
	Receive and store the signed Learner Remote Invigilation Declaration Form	
	Book onscreen test and add Remote Invigilation if needed – at least 7 days' notice required on bookings	
	Provide the learners email address as soon as you have made the test booking	
	Check in with learner 2 days prior to exam date to ensure that they have received their email and passed all system checks for Remote Invigilation	
	Check in with learner after exam has been taken to ensure that everything worked	

Important

- ➔ If you do not submit the learner's email address, we will not be able to set the learner up to take their test using Remote Invigilation. You will have received a link to a form when we confirmed that we have completed your onboarding to use remote invigilation. - If a learner is not able to meet the requirements outlined in the [learner checklist](#) they will not be able to take their test using Remote Invigilation. You will need to cancel the test booking and work with the learner to deliver the test in centre.
- A strong, stable internet connection (preferably wired) is needed to successfully run assessments. If the internet connection drops, or the connection is weak, the assessment may crash and will not be recoverable or the upload of responses may fail and will not be retrievable. If this happens the learners' responses may be lost and the assessment attempt void.
- Equipment and internet connection are the learner's responsibility, Pearson will not be held responsible for equipment technical failures and/or internet connection.
