The crossword puzzle grid consists of the following numbered starting points:

- 1**: Down, starting at the top of the 4th column.
- 2**: Across, starting at the 2nd column and ending at the 12th column.
- 3**: Down, starting at the 1st column and ending at the 2nd column.
- 4**: Down, starting at the 4th column and ending at the 11th column.
- 5**: Across, starting at the 1st column and ending at the 11th column.
- 6**: Across, starting at the 4th column and ending at the 8th column.



Down

- 1 Used when the screw has to be flush with the work or below it.
- 3 Used to stick timber together.
- 4 Easy to punch below the surface of timber and used for fine work.

Across

- 2 Name for several different types of wood with different uses and strengths.
- 5 Used to attach door handles.
- 6 Made from timber (veneers), glued together and available in different grades.
