You will use a range of fixtures and materials for your work. Look at the stool and the pictures of materials. When could you use these?

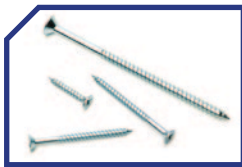




## Activity 2: Fixing it together

Sizes from 20mm to 40mm. Easy to punch below the surface of the timber. Used for fine work.

Sizes from 25mm to 100mm. Less likely to split the grain of the timber. Used for high-quality work.

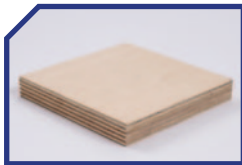
Made from thin layers of timber (veneers), glued together. Available in different grades.

These are used when the screw has to be flush with the work or below it.
